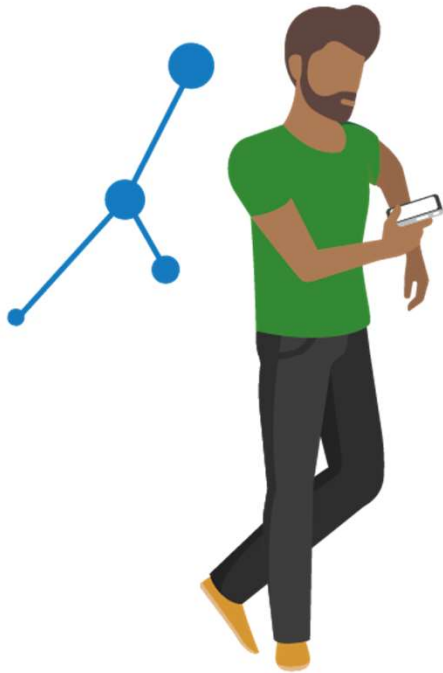

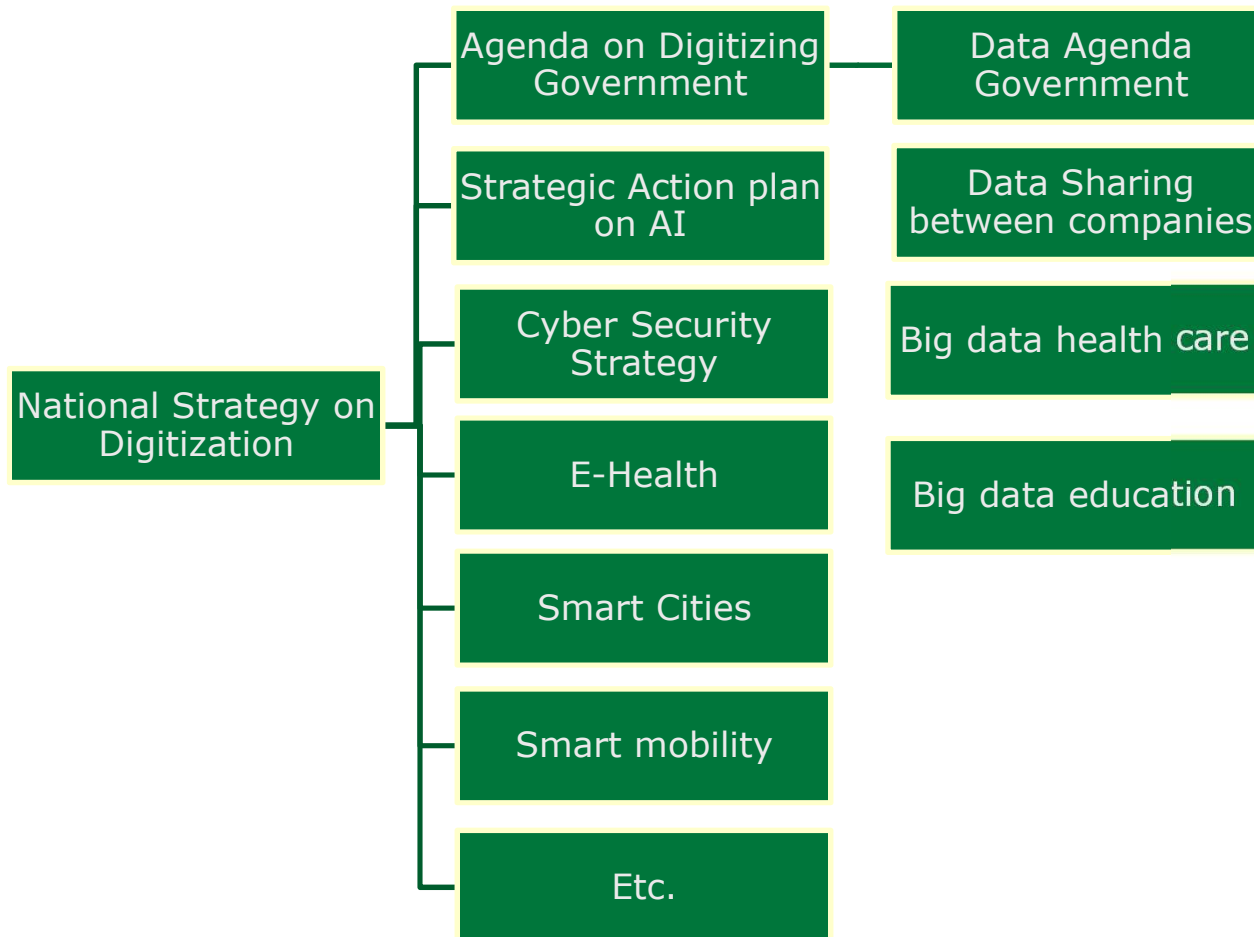
# Why a data agenda government?

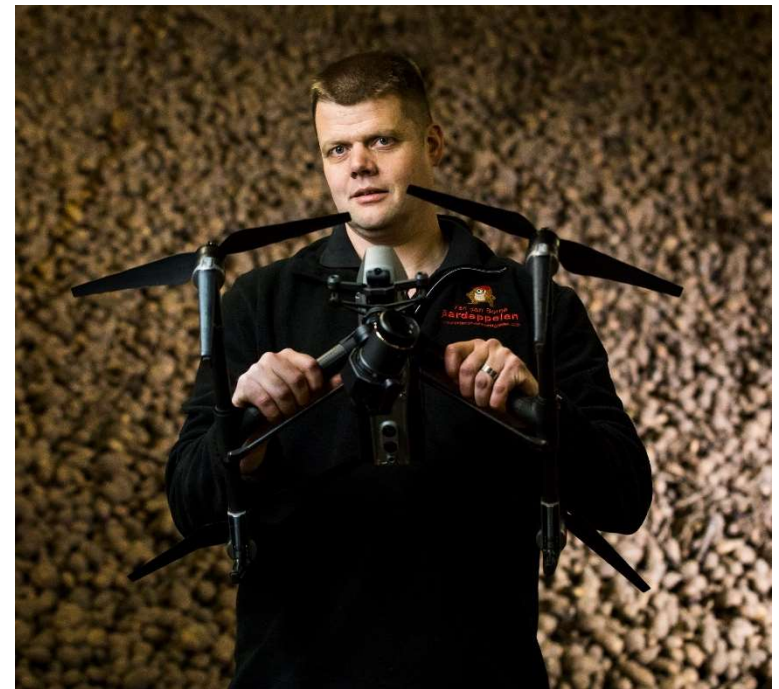

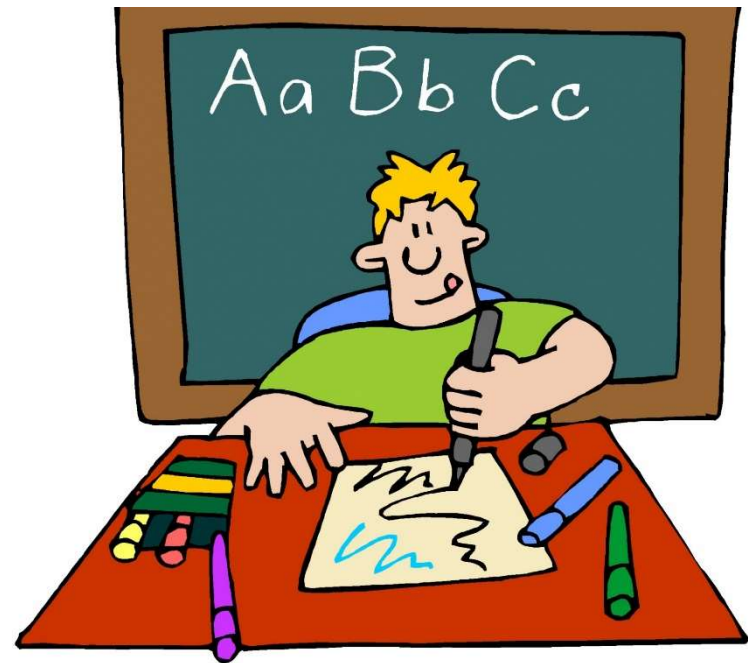
